Deeper Connection

Read John 4:1-42

1. What social and cultural barriers does Jesus cross? How are the disciples surprised?
2. What does Jesus mean when he offers "living water" and how would this appeal to the woman's deepest needs?
3. How does their conversation get more personal and how does the woman grow in her understanding of who Jesus is?
4. How significant is the action of the woman leaving her jar (v. 28)? What does she say to the townspeople and what compels her to do this (vv. 29-30)?
5. What is the outcome of the woman's testimony (vv. 39-42)?
6. How are you sharing your story of knowing Jesus? How can you be more intentional about influencing others for God's kingdom?
