

Daniel 2 Small Group Questions:



- 1) What stood out to you about Ben's message and this passage?
- 2) Think back to a time when you faced an impossible situation or circumstance. What did you do and how did you respond?
- 3) Why do you think Nebuchadnezzar asked someone to tell him his dream instead of telling them the dream first? What was he afraid of by telling them his dream?
- 4) Daniel's first response when he hears about needing to interpret and tell Nebuchadnezzar the dream he had is to plead to God and seek out His mercy. Why is it so important for us as Christians to seek out Jesus in those times that seem impossible?
- 5) How does our God use our situations and circumstances that seem impossible for both His glory and our good?
- 6) Re-read through Daniel's prayer again in Daniel 2:20-23. What stands out to you about Daniel's prayer, and how should this impact our response to when God is active in our lives?
- 7) Notice in telling and interpreting the dream of Nebuchadnezzar that Daniel points back to God who gave him this wisdom and discernment and who is establishing His kingdom. What are ways that you are right now showing others in your life that God is the source of your wisdom, joy, peace, and what you have currently?
- 8) Daniel 2 is the continuation of the story that if we want to see God work in our lives we need to continue to live in His ways. How are you planning on living in God's ways this week?
