➤ SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS:

- Name 3 things that you are passionate about
- In the first few verses, Paul describes the Jews as having “zeal for the Lord” without “knowledge” of the Lord
 - In what ways have you seen the Jews’ passion for God in Scripture?
 - How could someone have passion for the things of God, but not “know” God?
- What form of “righteousness” did the Jews submit to since Paul said that they failed to submit to “God’s Righteousness”?
 - Why might it be difficult for the Jews to see Jesus as the “culmination” or “end of the law”?
 - How might that force their entire culture to change their view of righteousness & how they live?
- Re-Read verses 5-12
 - Verses 5-8 is Paul’s description of the contrast between “righteousness that is by the law” & “righteousness that is by faith
 - Explain verses 9-13 in your own words
 - Does this mean that if we speak these words without any behavioral change that we now “follow Jesus Christ” & will be saved?
 - How do we reconcile this passage with other areas in Scripture that speak at length to the concept of “faith without works is dead”?
- The final verses speak about Paul’s continued lament over his countrymen who have failed to “submit to the righteousness of God”. Who do you need to continue to pray for that is still far from God?
