➤ SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS:

- Name 3 things that you are passionate about
- What does “remnant” mean?
- What did Paul say about whether God had rejected His people (Israel) or not?
 - What does “Israel failed to obtain what it was seeking” mean from verse 7?
- Explain in your own words, what Paul meant by “I magnify my ministry in order somehow to make my fellow Jews jealous, and thus save some of them” (v. 13-14)?
- Re-Read verses 17-24
 - What does the “root” represent? (v. 18)
 - What does the “cultivated olive tree” represent? (v. 24)
 - What does the “wild olive shoot” represent? (v. 17)
 - Explain the analogy in your own words
 - Explain the “Kindness & Severity of God” in your own words (v. 22)
 - Where have we seen these characteristics of God before?
- God’s warning of not being “arrogant toward the branches” is important why?
 - (Without naming names) In what ways have you witnessed (or done yourself) people being arrogant about their position of being righteous through faith in Jesus?
