- 1) What stood out to you about Ben's message and this passage?
- 2) Have you ever been in a situation where you were asked or invited to do something you knew was wrong? What happened?
- 3) Idol's are a big part of this story (specifically the image King Nebuchadnezzar builds to be worshipped). What is an idol and why does God command us to have no other idol's or God's before Him?
- 4) Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego chose not to bow down to the image of gold. While their decision makes sense, it isn't always easy to choose God in certain times. Why do we have difficulty at times choose God and His will, specifically in tough or difficult circumstances?
- 5) Re-read Daniel 3:16-18. What sticks out to you in these verses?
- 6) Focus on verse 18 specifically. Why should we point out that they were willing to be obedient to God even if God didn't save them?
- 7) Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego's faithfulness to God is prevalent in their decision to not worship God. Ben in the video talked about how our faith is an all or nothing thing. Do you agree with this?
